Revising using GCSEpod

Dear Parents and Carers,

GCSEpod is an online learning platform that we have purchased for our Year 11 students and is designed to be used independently without the need for teachers to set work.

- Regular users of GCSEpod achieve at least **1 grade higher** than non-users.
- Students can access GCSEpod **on their mobile phones**, and other electronic devices. Meaning they can access it at any point, anywhere.
- It consists of **short videos and questions**. This is an ideal way to improve their knowledge and learn in a fun, easy and interactive way.
- Please make sure your child has downloaded the App on their electronic devices.
- Encourage your child to use GCSEpod, at least once a day.



Most students should already have a login for GCSEpod. <https://www.gcsepod.com/>
 If not please get them to create their profile (Using their school email address).
 If any student has forgotten their login, make sure they talk to their tutors to get them reset.


1 Go to www.gcsepod.com and click 'Login'




2 Click on 'New to GCSEPod? Get Started'




3 Select 'Student' and enter your full name, date of birth and the name of your school.



Your school name will appear underneath for you to click on

4 Set a username and password for your account.



You'll then be logged in for the first time!
Next time just go straight to the login page and enter the username and password you created.
